If you are young and have questions about the body, sex and life in general, we are here for you. You can ask us about anything that you do not want to ask your friends, parents or other grown-ups. No question is too big or too small. We are here to support you and we take you seriously.

At the Väsby Youth Clinic, you can talk to midwives and counsellors. You can also book a time to see a gynaecologist or venereologist. Our midwives can help you with questions relating to your body, your gender and sex. For example, we can give you advice about the right contraceptive or condom. There is something appropriate for everyone. Our counsellors can help you if you need someone to talk to or want to discuss difficulties in your life. It is often good to be able to share one's thoughts with an outside party.


